Re: Outcome of Appeal Concerning the Application for University Status – MED.E.A Higher Institution for Mediterranean, Europe and Africa

Dear Professor Melillo,

I am writing to formally inform you that the Appeals Panel appointed by the Malta Further and Higher Education Authority (MFHEA) has concluded its review of your appeal regarding the accreditation decision related to the application for University Status.

Following an independent evaluation of all evidence and documentation submitted, the Appeals Panel has decided to overturn the original decision issued by the original University Expert Panel. In light of this revised outcome, the Appeals Panel has recommended that MED.E.A Higher Institution for Mediterranean, Europe and Africa be granted the status of a university and a refund of twenty-five per cent (25%) of the applicable fees. Kindly provide the relevant IBAN details to enable the processing of this refund.

Further to the issuance of this letter, the MFHEA will proceed to publish an announcement on its official website. Additionally, the Malta Qualifications Database and the institution's licence will be updated to reflect the recognition of MED.E.A Higher Institution for Mediterranean, Europe and Africa as a university, with effect from the date of publication of the Appeals Panel's report.
